

## Making Paypal Payment with Exchange Charges

Laurence McAuley asked me to contact you to let you know how I paid for the Gathering using PayPal. Here's what I did:

- Log onto your PayPal account
- Click on "Pay or send money"
- Choose "Send money to friends and family"
- Type this email address into the "email..." field:  
[john@podware.co.uk](mailto:john@podware.co.uk)  
"The Honorable Clan MacAulay" will be displayed.
- Click "Next"
- Under "Recipient gets", type in ONLY the amount you owe for the Gathering.  
***Don't add anything extra.*** (If you don't know what you owe, contact  
Laurence McAuley for the amount in GBP -- British pounds sterling.)
- The amount you entered in pounds will be converted and entered in dollars  
in the "You send" field.
- Click the green "Continue" button.

At this point, you'll see a summary of the transaction. You'll see a fee has been added to the amount you're sending. It's PayPal's charge for converting the currency. I have not seen a way to avoid paying this, as it's automatically added to your total.

The last step is to "Send the money."
